

HELPFUL APPOINTMENT TOOLS

Attached to this Preparation Guide, you will find the following:

/ SELECTIONS GUIDE

The Selections Guide is a visual tool which shows options available to you in your electrical appointment. These include Power, Lighting, Security, Home Comfort and more.

Use the tick boxes to select items you would like in your home or would like more information on.

/ AMPHIS BEST SELLERS

This guide shows you most of our pendant range by colour, to help you narrow down your decorative lighting selections for your appointment. It also shows when pendants come in a variety of shapes and sizes, and if they have a matching wall lighting option.





FIVE STEPS TO GET YOU READY

/ ONE - PLAN YOUR FURNITURE LAYOUT

Before your Electrical appointment it is important to start with your furniture layout. Attached is a blank copy of your house plans – print, mark up and draw on the plans where you envision your furniture to be placed in your home. This will then help you position where you need extra powerpoints or lighting in your new home.

/ TWO - ELECTRICAL MARK UP

Once you have created your furniture layout plan, it's time to think about and mark up your electrical points. Using the Checklist and Selections Guide with your plans, start to think about all items we offer and what you'd like included. A few points to think about are:

- Any additional powerpoints required
- Any additional TV, data, phone or Foxtel points required
- Location of light switches or dimmers
- External powerpoints and lighting

/ THREE - LIGHTING YOUR HOME

Once you have completed your furniture layout and electrical mark up, it's time to think about any additional lighting. Refer again to the Checklist and Selections Guide alongside your furniture layout and electrical plans. A few top points to think about are:

- Ceiling height can affect what brightness/ wattage you will need
- Downlights throughout the entire home or perhaps just the living areas
- Any feature lighting? Pendants/Wall lights
- External lighting required in the front or backyard areas

/ FOUR - VIEW AMPHIS WEBSITE

If you have a Staircase or Void, there are fees for lighting to be installed in these areas.



MARKING UP YOUR ELECTRICAL PLANS

/ INCLUSIONS

You would have received a copy of your standard electrical plans which indicate the current placements of lighting and electrical points in your chosen home. Carefully look through each room so you can see what you currently have included and what areas need to be added to or changed.

/ HIGHLIGHT

Select a range of colourful highlighters of your choice, and begin to mark on your electrical plans where you would like additional downlights, double powerpoints, external lights, feature lighting etc.

/ LABEL

Make sure you've clearly labeled your electrical plans with a colour coded legend, so that we can prepare for your electrical appointment and know where you would like your chosen lighting and electrical points.

/ SEND

Don't forget to send through via email a copy of your marked up electrical plans alongside this guide to your Electrical Design Consultant.
